- MKA follows a modified FCI 7 Group system. For more info about MKA groups please visit www.dogsmalaysia.my
- To qualify for the title of Malaysian Champion a dog must be over 15 months old and win 3 CAC. Those below 15 months are eligible for the Malaysian Junior Champion title by winning 3 JCAC.
- MKA CHALLENGE CERTIFICATE'S (CAC) & Junior Challenge Certificates (JCAC) will be awarded at all shows in every class. CACIB'S will be awarded at the FCI INTERNATIONAL DOG SHOWS, to exhibits entered in the Intermediate and Open class ONLY. There is NO Champion Class on offer at these shows.
- Winners of the MKA CHALLENGE CERTIFICATE'S (CAC) at the 19th & 20th MKA FCI A2O CHAMPIONSHIP
 SHOW will be awarded A2O Champion CAC which goes towards their FCI A2O Champion Title.
- Winners of Dog & Bitch CAC, Dog & Bitch winners from the Junior Class in Breed & Dog & Bitch winners from the Veteran Class in Breed at the 51st MKA FCI INTERNATIONAL DOG SHOW will be eligible for the title of Kuala Lumpur Winner 2019, Kuala Lumpur Junior Winner 2019 & Kuala Lumpur Veteran Winner 2019.
- Winners of the MKA CHALLENGE CERTIFICATE'S (CAC) at the 10th MKA SOUTH EAST ASIAN CHAMPIONSHIP SHOW will be awarded SEA Champion CAC which goes towards their SEA Champion Title.
- There is no charge for entering the Malaysian Derby Winner 2019. All exhibits born from January 1st to December 31st 2017 and entered at the 56th MKA FCI INTERNATIONAL DOG SHOW 2019 are eligible for this additional title and competition. (See last page for more information)

General Information

Quarantine Waiver

The MKA has managed to get Quarantine waiver for overseas dogs wishing to participate at these shows. All dogs must have valid Rabies Vaccinations and regular vaccinations to enable them entry under the Quarantine Waiver scheme. Dogs from THAILAND in addition to the above, MUST also have a valid Rabies Titre Test and will be required to produce the ORIGINAL Titre Certificate on entry into Malaysia. No photocopies or Digital Copies will be permitted.

Please take note that for the following breeds of dogs will not be granted Quarantine Waiver:

All overseas participants <u>MUST</u> submit all entries ONLINE at <u>www.dogsmalaysia.my</u> on or before **6pm**, **23**rd **August 2019**

Import Permits

The MKA will be organizing the application of Import permits and Waiver of Quarantine for All overseas exhibitors. The fee payable for this service is **RM175 per dog**. All overseas participants are also required to pay **RM150** Admin Charge **per owner**.

Export Permits

The MKA will also be organizing inspection of dogs for the Export Permit and Health certs at the show venue on Friday 20th September 2019. Cost for the Inspection Fee is **RM120 per exhibitor** and cost for Export Permit & Health Cert is **RM105 per dog**. Fee is subject to change. We strongly recommend that you do not book your return flights till after 12pm on Monday 23rd September 2019 in case of any issues with the issuing of Export Permits and Health Certificates.

Vaccinations

All Vaccinations, including Rabies Vaccinations must be done at least 30 days before arrival in Malaysia and Vaccination cards MUST be endorsed by the Competent Authority (Government Vet Dept) and not just private Veterinary practice. Dogs from Thailand must have a valid Rabies Titre Test from an OIE ISO approved laboratory.

Microchips

All dogs entering Malaysia **MUST** be microchipped with a **15 digit ISO certified** and readable microchip. The microchip numbers will be checked on entry into and on departure from KLIA. If you are using an AVID chip you MUST bring along your own microchip scanner. Otherwise **AVID chips will NOT be allowed**.

Import Clearance

For Import clearance all Dogs entering Malaysia must produce – Original Export Health Cert from Country of Export, Original Export Permit from Country of Export and also Import permit for return to Country of origin. Dogs from THAILAND must produce the ORIGINAL Titre Certificate on entry into Malaysia. No photocopies or Digital Copies will be permitted.

Arrival & Departure

All overseas exhibits must arrive in Malaysia via the designated entry point, Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA) no earlier than **Wednesday 18th September 2019** and must depart on or before **Wednesday 25th September 2019** .

Acceptance of Entries

A reminder that the MKA will only accept entries from overseas participants who have obtained the Import permit through us.

Payment

Entries for ALL overseas entries <u>MUST</u> be made online via our website <u>www.dogsmalaysia.my</u> We strongly advise you to put your entries in well in advance so that we are able to help you out should there be any problems. Full amount for your transport services need to be paid direct to the relevant parties. Refundable Security Deposit of RM250 per room will also be charged at the time of booking. Any damage to room or property will be deducted from Security Deposit. <u>The</u> Landlord will return security deposit to you directly upon checking out.

Transportation

a) Private Van Hire

The cost of hiring a private van for a day (12 hours) is RM650.

b) Airport & Show pick up and drop off service

Price for ONE WAY is RM200 for -

- 3 Small crates (Yorkie/Maltese/Shih Tzu size) PLUS 2 passengers, OR
- 2 Medium crates (Beagle size) PLUS 2 passengers, OR
- 1 Large crate (Siberian/Golden size) PLUS 2 passengers.

Accommodation

All hotels in Malaysia will not allow dogs into their hotels due to their Halal Status. As such we can assist you to book homestays if you require our assistance or you can make your own bookings accordingly.

Private Bungalow House (45 minutes drive from show venue)

We have managed to get a private Bungalow house where you can stay together with your dogs in the bedrooms. There is a large garden for you to let your dogs loose to exercise. You have to bring your own towels and toiletries as this is a home stay concept Bungalow. All rooms are airconditioned.

Cost per night

Twin room - RM200 (Max 2 people occupancy

Refundable Security Deposit of RM250 per room will also be charged at the time of booking. Any damage to room or property will be deducted from Security Deposit. The Landlord will return security deposit to you directly upon checking out.

If you are staying at this venue you will have to hire a private van, to transport you to the show venue and back. This will be a separate charge. Depending on the number of people choosing to stay here and the breeds of dogs here, we may be able to determine if a van can be shared. The cost of hiring a private van for a day (12 hours) is RM650.

REMINDERS

All overseas participants MUST submit all entries ONLINE at www.dogsmalaysia.my on or before 6pm, 23rd August 2019

Before making online entries, please ensure you have the following documents available or else we cannot accept your entry:

- 1. Vaccination Card of Animal Including Rabies and Regular Vaccinations, complete with Microchip number stated.
- 2. Dogs from Thailand MUST have a valid Rabies Titre Certificate
- 3. Passport Information page of the Person Traveling with the Dog
- 4. Flight Booking information/ Flight Ticket with complete Itinerary
- 5. Pedigree Certificate of the Dog, preferably with Microchip number stated.

If any of the required forms are missing or illegible, we reserve the right to reject the application. We recommend you do your online entries early, so we can contact you if anything is missing or illegible!!

Deposits taken whilst paying online for accommodation & anything else will be refunded to you by the MKA at the dog show. Full amounts for these services need to be paid direct to the relevant parties.

Seeing the success of the Derby Winner title we ran in 2018, the MKA once again having the **MALAYSIAN DERBY WINNER 2019** as part of our International Show in September 2019.

The nominated show for the Malaysian Derby Winner is the 56th MKA FCI INTERNATIONAL DOG SHOW 2019 on 22.09.2019.

RULES & REGULATIONS FOR MALAYSIAN DERBY WINNER 2019

- 1. All dogs born from **January 1st to December 31st 2017** are eligible to enter and win the Malaysian Derby 2019 title.
- 2. There will be only one (1) Malaysian Derby Winner for each breed. The selection of Derby winner within the breed will be regardless of sex and will be all judged together if the Best of Breed is not eligible.
- 3. If the Best of Breed is not eligible for the title, the ring steward will call in all eligible dogs born in 2017 and the judge will pick the Derby Winner for the breed.
- 4. There will be no Group Derby Winners. All Derby Winners from breeds in each Group will compete together in a sweepstakes with all other Derby Winners at the end.
- 5. The finals Judge will select dogs from all the Derby Winners from each breed and ultimately award Best Malaysian Derby in Show 1-4.
- 6. Judging of Malaysian Derby Winner will be done before judging of BIS.

There is no charge for entering the Malaysian Derby Winner 2019. All exhibits born in 2017 and entered at the **56th MKA FCI INTERNATIONAL DOG SHOW 2019** are eligible for this additional title and competition.
