Together with her husband Werner, Ursula bred 29 litters of German Shepherd Dogs "von der Schafbachmuehle" since 1986. Their focus in breeding is preserving the utility qualities of this working dog.

For many years she was active as a breed warden, today she provides all breeder's training and information in the Schaeferhundverein RSV2000, an international club for German Shepherd dogs, based in Germany.

In her professional life she is a personal and product trainer. She proposed talks and seminars for breeders of all breeds in Germany, Finland and Indonesia, especially about the German Shepherd also in Russia and South Korea.

In 2002 a book about German Shepherds, written by Ursula was published (Mueller Rueschlikon, 2002).

Ursula's special interest in breeding are the modern possibilities of genetics (avoid inbreeding, genome scans), reproduction and neonatology, focusing the mental development of puppies.

Ursula and Werner have two adult children, they both live in a mountain area in Germany (Eifel) near Cologne together with their two German Shepherds Alec and Cookie.
