

# Revisions to MKA Dog Show Rules - January 2024

Kindly take note of some revisions to the MKA Dog Show Rules which come into immediate effect.

The qualifications for the following Champion titles have been revised according to the conditions stipulated below. All awards attained and won prior to January 2024 will still count towards attaining these titles.

#### **MALAYSIAN JUNIOR CHAMPION TITLE**

**Junior Champion** - The Association hereby grants that any Dog/Bitch winning a total of **four (4) Junior Challenge Certificates** (JCAC) from the Puppy or Junior classes, by Judges or panels of Judges at Championship shows held by the Association or by Affiliate clubs of the Association, shall be entitled to the title of **Malaysian Junior Champion (MYS. JR. CH)**, so long as at least <u>two (2)</u> of the **Junior Challenge Certificates** (JCAC) was won whilst competing in the Junior Class.

## **MALAYSIAN CHAMPION TITLE**

the dog won Res. Best in Show.

**Adult Champion** - The Association hereby grants that any Dog/Bitch winning a total of **six (6) Challenge Certificates** (CAC) by Judges or panels of Judges at Championship shows held by the Association or by Affiliate clubs of the Association, shall be entitled to the title of **Malaysian Champion (MYS. CH).** There is no time frame for the accumulation of the 6 CACs.

All applications for the title of **Malaysian Champion & Malaysian Junior Champion** must be made on a separate form with details of all relevant criteria, for approval and official recording by the MKA inclusive of admin fee.

## MALAYSIAN GRAND CHAMPION TITLE (MYS. GR. CH.)

The title of **Malaysian Grand Champion (Mys. Gr. Ch.)** can be attained by dogs and bitches over the age of 15 months who meet the following criteria.

1 Best in Show + 6 CC's	6
1 Res. Best in Show + 6 other* Best in Groups	7
4 Best in Groups + 12 Best of Breed (BOB)	12
1 Best in Group + 5 Res. Best in Groups + 17 BOB	17
25 Best of Breed	25
* Other refers to groups that must be won in addition to the Group won when	

All applications for the title of **Grand Champion** must be made on a separate form with details of all relevant criteria, for approval and official recording by the MKA inclusive of admin fee.

## MALAYSIAN HALL OF FAME (MYS. HOF.)

Best in Show or Res. Best in Show.

The title of Malaysian Hall of Fame (Mys. HOF.) can be attained by dogs over the age of 15 months who meet the following criteria.

Criteria	Min. No. of shows to be attended.
3 Best in Show + 5 other* Group 1 <sup>st</sup> placing (BIG1)	8
2 Best in Show + 2 Res. Best in Show + 5 other* BIG1	9
1 Best in Show + 15 other* BIG1	16
30 BIG1	30
* Other refers to groups that must be won in addition to the Group won when the dog won	

All applications for the title of Hall of Fame must be made on a separate form with details of all relevant criteria, for approval and official recording by the MKA inclusive of admin fee.

# Kindly take note of some revisions to the definition and classification of the criteria below which come into immediate effect.

**VETERAN**: For dogs of any age specified in the schedule but not less than 8 (eight) years on the day of the show. Dogs in the Veteran class are NOT eligible for MKA CC, but eligible for Best of Sex and Best of Breed competition. Dogs eligible for the Veteran class who are already MYS Champions, can only enter either one of the classes — Veteran or Champion — but not both.

#### **BEST VETERAN OF BREED**

Judging of Best Veteran of Breed is to be done after conclusion of Best of Breed. If the Best of Breed or Reserve of Breed winners come from this class, they will automatically be deemed the respective winner of these breed categories.
