COMPETITION



Rules of Competition

1. CLASSES

TINY TOTS – Children over 4 and under 7 who are MKA members, children or ward of MKA members. AGE GROUP 1 - Boys and girls aged 7 years and over under 12 years who are MKA members, children or ward of MKA members.

AGE GROUP 2 - Boys and girls who are over 12 5. ENTRY years and under 18 years of age on the day of competition who are MKA members, children or ward of MKA members.

2. AGE LIMITS

TINY TOTS - Children over 4 and under 7 on day of competition.

AGE GROUP 1 - The handler must be 7 years and over and under 12 years on day of competition.

AGE GROUP 2 - The handler must be over 12 years and under 18 years on day of competition.

3. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded at end of judging as follows for each of the three Age Groups:

1st - Prize

2nd-Prize

3rd - Prize

4th - Prize

4. JUDGING

Judging shall be based on the following criteria:

- a. **70 points** for the correct handling, exhibition and presentation of the dog.
- b. 15 points for the handlers' attire, having regard to its suitability to the occasion and its harmony with the exhibit.
- c. 15 points for the preparation, grooming and presentation of the dog.
- d. The judges and stewards shall require the dog to be paraded around the ring in the same manner or pattern as that required in ordinary conformation shows.
- e. Fancy dress or other attire that is unsuited to the efficient exhibition of the dogs will be penalised.

Con't...

In coming to a decision, the judges will keep the foregoing five rules firmly in mind and select the handler who is best equipped to handle a dog in open competition.

a. Entry form to be submitted with a copy of handler's Birth Certificate or Identity Card.

6. GENERAL

The handlers will have to arrange for their own dogs to participate.

Judge's decision is final and the score sheets are strictly meant for the MKA only and not to be distributed to anyone else.

For the safety of the other handlers and dogs, Judge/Steward reserve the right to ask handlers who are not able to manage their dogs to leave the ring.
